Additional Information

Ayr Racecourse (2025)

Members will receive complimentary Club/Single Enclosure entry to the racecourse on your allocated reciprocal day.

Please go with your racecourse badge/membership card to the **Princess Royal Reception** or **Gate C** where you will be given a ticket to gain entry.

We do not have dress code – please just dress for the weather and we kindly ask for no football colours. Gates will open two hours before the first race, however all up to date race times can be checked on our website.

Ayr Racecourse offers free public parking adjacent to Tesco. Parking is also available for disabled badge holders in Car Park 5. Coach parking is in the centre of the course through Gate A on Craigie Road. Please note all car parks are on a first come first served basis.

Ascot Racecourse (2025)

- Access: Reciprocal visitors will have complimentary access to the King Edward VII Enclosure on their designated day.
- Parking: Members should park in either Car Park 1 or 2, presenting their metal badge or pass card upon arrival to the Car Park.
- Ticket Collection: Once parked, Members should proceed to Ticket Office East, where they will receive their admission ticket upon showing their metal badge or pass card.
- King Edward VII Enclosure: The admission ticket provides access to Level 4 of the Grandstand. Please note that, due to limited capacity, reciprocal visitors will not have access to the Members Bar on Level 4.
- Dress Code: We kindly remind visitors to review the dress code for their raceday on our website: Ascot Dress Code.

Ballinrobe Racecourse

Please see below some information for your members when attending Ballinrobe Racecourse:

- All car parking is free, please follow the directions of the stewards on the day
- Please proceed to the AIR and Membership desk on the right-hand side of the main entrance hall and present your membership card
- Please be advised that traffic is particularly heavy in the town of Ballinrobe on race days therefore please allow plenty of time to get to the racecourse
- Information regarding opening times, start times and useful information can be found on our website www.ballinroberacecourse.ie. Please be advised that start times may change so please keep up to date with our website.

Bangor on Dee (2025)

Parking – Free of charge located in the main public car park.

Access – Paddock Enclosure. The Paddock Enclosure at Bangor-on-Dee gets you close to the pre-amble, the post-race celebrations and the presentations to winning connections. This enclosure incorporates the Pre-Parade, Parade Ring and Winner's Enclosure, as well as fantastic views of the home straight. A paddock ticket a popular choice for racegoers looking for the perfect combination of spectacular views of the track and full use of Bangor-on-Dee's facilities.

Amenities include access to three public bars under-cover, food concessions and Bangor Tote betting terminals, the Bangor Sport Betting Shop, in which you can place a bet on any sport, anywhere in the country and the independent bookmakers, located on the hard standing adjacent to the Parade Ring.

Entrance – Please enter the racecourse via main gates

Dress code– There is no formal dress code

Bath

Chelmsford Members will have access to the General Admission areas but not any Member Lounge.

Dress Code is detailed below:

We want you to thoroughly enjoy your day at Bath Races, which is why across most of the racecourse there is no formal dress code enforced. We want you to be comfortable but most racegoers go for a smart casual outfit.

Brighton (2025)

Parking – Free of charge, and located in the main public car park.

Entrance – Please enter the racecourse through the main entrance, and show the relevant members' badge to the gate staff to gain admission.

Enclosures – Reciprocals will have access to both our Grandstand & Paddock, and Premier Enclosures.

Members Lounge – Due to limited capacity, unfortunately your members will not have access to the Annual Members Lounge.

Dress code – There is no strict dress code, although many visitors choose to dress for the occasion and a smart/casual look is often adopted by many racegoers. Our only stipulation is that we cannot permit sporting team shirts or offensive fancy dress.

Cartmel (2025)

Your members attending Cartmel will receive free entry to both the Paddock and Course enclosures and free parking in the members only parking area - follow the signs towards the Paddock and take the turn off for members parking before approaching the Paddock Enclosure.

Due to restrictions on numbers, we are unable to allow entry to the members marquee or viewing platform.

Catterick (2025)

- Parking is free of charge and located in the main public car park.
- We do not have a member's bar.
- We have two enclosures, and your members have access to both.
- We do not have dress code – please just dress for the weather.

Chester (2025)

Parking: Free of charge located in the main public car park.

Access: County Concourse. The County Concourse is one of our more premium enclosures in the general admission areas. This enclosure forms part of our iconic panoramic grandstand which is home to our exclusive private boxes.

Key Information about the County Concourse:

- Access to both sides of the track (including the Paddock Area)
- Admission to the County Champagne Bar
- Trackside viewing of the final furlong & winning post
- Betting facilities & racecards available to purchase
- Variety of food & drink vendors available

Entrance: Please enter the racecourse via Gate 3A/Gate 11 and show your badge/card at the entrance.

Dress code: Please wear either a polo shirt or collared shirt, Smart (not ripped) jeans, trousers or chinos or a smart dress. Please note - Trainers, shorts, tracksuits, t-shirts, sportswear, and fancy dress are not permitted in the County Concourse or Tattersalls enclosures.

Curragh (2025)

Parking - Free parking in the Orange (North) car park, across the road from the entrance to The Curragh.

Reciprocal Tickets – Available at the members check in on production of valid Reciprocal track members' badge/card. Children under 18 are free with an adult but must have a valid ticket available at the members area. Admission is to all public areas. No admission to the Members lounge due to space restrictions.

Dress Code – Smart casual

There will be courtesy buses to and from Kildare and Newbridge train stations, times of which will be on our website prior to the race day for each route, under the dropdown menu heading of **Plan your Visit,**

Transport and parking. The routes are as follows:

- Kildare train station - Kildare tourist office (bus stop) – the Curragh North car park.
- Newbridge train station - The Curragh North Car park.

All guests at the Curragh must adhere to the Curragh Code of Conduct on the T's and C's which is available on the website.

Down Royal (2025)

Please use Turnstile One, showing your annual badges/cards.

Exeter (2025)

Your members will have access to the Haldon Premier and Grandstand & Paddock enclosures.

Unfortunately, your members will not have access to our member's room due to space restrictions. There is no formal dress code, but we do encourage smart/ casual attire as well as to dress for the weather. Parking is free and is located in the centre of the course.

Fontwell Park

Your members will have access to the Grandstand and Premier Enclosure. Unfortunately they will not have access to the members room.

Dress Code: Hospitality Suites and Premier: Men should wear collared shirts. A tie is not essential. Smart jeans and tailored shorts are acceptable (they must not be ripped or torn). We do not permit jogging bottoms, fancy dress, sports or beach wear, non-tailored shorts and trainers. Many customers opt to dress for the occasion on feature race days.

Grandstand & Paddock Enclosure: There is no dress code in this enclosure, however, any offensive clothing will not be tolerated and may be asked to be covered up. Parking in our main front car park is free of charge.

Galway

Getting Here: Located just off the M6 motorway, Galway Racecourse is easily accessible from Dublin, Cork, Limerick, or any other location around Ireland.

Dress Code: It is advisable to check the weather when planning your outfit for racing. There is no official dress code at Irish racecourses, but smart casual is usually a safe bet.

Children: Children 17 & under are admitted FREE but they must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian.

Goodwood (2025)

Your members will have access to the Richmond Enclosure, which is our Members enclosure. Unfortunately, your members will not have access to our Annual Badge Holders Bar. Please present your metal badge to the ticket scanner at any entrance in order to gain entry to the course.

We do have a dress code in the Richmond enclosure, we regret that anyone deemed to be dressed inappropriately will not be admitted to the Richmond Enclosure.

All – jeans, shorts and fancy dress are not permitted into the Richmond enclosure.

Gentlemen – required to wear a jacket and tie at all race meetings.

Ladies – should dress smartly. Stilettoes are not recommended due to the terrain and use of decking.

Children – must be dressed smartly. Boys aged 16 + are required to follow the dress code for gentlemen.

Boys aged 7-15 are kindly requested to wear a long-sleeved collared shirt.

Parking is free in No 8. car park, your members will just need to show their badge or card to gain entry.

Great Yarmouth

Please advise your members that they can park for FOC in the main car park.

Huntingdon Racecourse

When your members visit Huntingdon Racecourse, please can they head to the turnstiles at our main entrance and show their relevant members' badge. This will allow them access to the course. Parking is free of charge onsite. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer access to our members bar for reciprocal guests.

Hickstead Ltd, All England Jumping Course

- Your badge entitles you to access to the showground and into the Members' Enclosure
- Our gate staff are briefed to ensure they are fully aware of which reciprocal members are visiting and the colour/style of their badges.
- Gate opening and times can be found on our website www.hickstead.co.uk
- You will have access to the Members' car park
- All reciprocal members are entitled to book a table in our Members' Restaurant, subject to availability. Please call the hospitality team on 01273 837253
- A 'smart casual' code is applicable
- Smart jeans, shorts and trainers are accepted (no ripped or faded denim)
- No sportswear

Kelso (2025)

Parking: Free of charge located in the main public car park

Entrance: Please enter the racecourse through the Club Office to the right of the main gate where their badge number will be noted.

Annual Members Bar: Sadly we have limited capacity so we cannot allow reciprocal visitors access.

Dress Code: Smart casual and dress for the weather!

Leicester (2025)

- Free parking in Car Park A
- They will be given a Members day badge and can join our Members in the dedicated room for that day.
- Complimentary Tea and Coffee and free race card.
- Dress code nothing offensive inc. football shirts but dress for the weather!

Leopardstown (2025)

Bus – We provide a free shuttle bus to and from Sandyford LUAS stop for every meeting. On bigger Raceday's we also provide a free shuttle bus from Blackrock DART station, Naas Town Centre and Heuston Station. Please check our website and social media pages for updates on our shuttle bus services.

Taxi –The taxi drop off and pick up is in Car Park A.

Train- Depending on the Race Meeting, we provide complimentary shuttle buses to the racecourse from Blackrock Train Station and Hueston Train Station. Please check our website for up-to-date information on this.

Luas – Sandyford Luas Station is within a 20-minute walk of the racecourse. Central Park Luas Station is within a 15-minute walk of the Racecourse. We provide a free shuttle bus to and from Sandyford LUAS stop for every meeting.

Car – There is free car parking available to all guests. All car parks are within a 5-minute walk of the turnstiles. On arrival at the racecourse, all racegoers will be directed into our free onsite parking by our traffic stewards. Alternatively, we have accessibility parking onsite. However, racegoers will have to contact us in advance and provide details of their transport so we can inform our stewards to ensure disability parking access is granted.

All Members must enter through our Main Turnstiles, which is beside McGuirks Golf Shop. Members must show their Card and/or badge to gain admission to the Racecourse. Members may be required to pick up a ticket at our collection/courtesy desk which will provide them with access to the Racecourse.

We advise all guests of our smart casual dress code. However, we recommend to dress for the weather.

Facilities

- Members will have access to all of our public areas which includes our Grandstand (Sports Lounge, Food and Tote Hall on Ground Floor and Champions Bar and The Paddocks Dining on Level 1), Racing Hall and all outdoor food and drink units. The Circle Lounge is also accessible to our visiting Members except at our Festival Meetings, which includes The Dublin Racing Festival, Champions Weekend and The Christmas Festival.
- We accept both cash and card payments across the site however we do have ATM machines which can be found within the grandstand on the ground floor and at the Racecard/Information Hut.
- We have TOTE and Paddy Power betting facilities available onsite as well as our on-course bookmakers in our bookmakers' ring.
- For any Race Day queries, we have an information desk onsite which is located just through the main turnstiles, on the left-hand side

Musselburgh (2025)

- Dress code – Generally, there is no particular dress code at Musselburgh Racecourse. We suggest you dress for the weather & wear what you feel comfortable in for a day of outdoor entertainment. All public walk areas are paved so suitable for any form of footwear.
- Arrival – Members can use Car Park 3, free of charge. Prior booking is not required.
- Entrance – Please enter via Gate 2 & produce your membership badge/card.
- Facilities – We do not have separate enclosures at Musselburgh, so all public areas, including the Grandstand and the viewing area for the Parade Ring, can be accessed during your visit. Access to our Owners & Trainers Area and the Parade Ring itself will not be permitted. All public bars are open to your members. Unfortunately, we do not have a separate Members Bar available for reciprocals.

Newbury (2025)

Please ask your visiting Members to park in either Car Park 1 or 4 – parking is free. For either car park they will be able to gain access using their relevant Members car park label or their metal badge. Once parked, at each of our entrance points, on presentation of their metal badge/pass card, they will be given a Premier admission ticket, which allows access to the Parade Ring, our Dubai Duty Free, Berkshire and Hampshire Grandstands, (barring hospitality areas and our Owners Club).
